## **Eligibility:**

The applicant must attend a high school or be home schooled within the Chapter's catchment area which encompasses:

- RSU1 Bath, Phippsburg, Woolwich
- RSU2 Dresden, Richmond
- RSU4 Litchfield
- RSU5 Durham, Freeport, Pownal
- MSAD75 Bowdoin, Bowdoinham, Harpswell, Topsham
- AOS98 Boothbay, Boothbay Harbor, Georgetown, Southport
- Other Arrowsic, Brunswick, Lisbon/Lisbon Falls, West Bath, Westport Island, Wiscasset
- Homeschoolers who live in these towns may also apply

The camper will be selected on the basis of a one-page student essay and the teacher's recommendation. The student should explain why they are interested in birds and what they hope to learn. The completed student application, essay, and recommendation are due by February 14, 2026.

#### Award:

The scholarship will cover the full camp tuition of (\$1,725). If selected, the student is responsible for submitting the Hog Island registration forms.
