

## OPPORTUNITY TO ATTEND HOG ISLAND TEEN CAMPS 2026

Merrymeeting Audubon, a Chapter of Maine Audubon, has reserved two spaces and is offering two scholarships to attend teen (ages 14-17 in June 2026) camps this coming summer. This program is located at the Hog Island Audubon Camp, Bremen, ME.

### **Eligibility:**

The applicant must attend a high school or be home schooled within the Chapter's catchment area which encompasses:

- RSU1 Bath, Phippsburg, Woolwich
- RSU2 Dresden, Richmond
- RSU4 Litchfield
- RSU5 Durham, Freeport, Pownal
- MSAD75 Bowdoin, Bowdoinham, Harpswell, Topsham
- AOS98 Boothbay, Boothbay Harbor, Georgetown, Southport
- Other Arrowsic, Brunswick, Lisbon/Lisbon Falls, West Bath, Westport Island, Wiscasset
- Homeschoolers who live in these towns may also apply

The camper will be selected on the basis of a one-page student essay and the teacher's recommendation. The student should explain why they are interested in birds and what they hope to learn. **The completed student application, essay, and recommendation are due by February 14, 2026.**

### **Award:**

The scholarship will cover the full camp tuition of (\$1,725). If selected, the student is responsible for submitting the Hog Island registration forms.
